HAVING

HAVING clause is used in combination with the GROUP BY clause to restrict the groups of returned rows to only those whose the condition is TRUE

Syntax

```
SELECT ColumnNames, aggregate_function (expression)
FROM tables
[WHERE conditions]
GROUP BY column1
HAVING condition;
```

HAVING clause is used in combination with the GROUP BY clause to restrict the groups of returned rows to only those whose the condition is TRUE

Example

```
SELECT region, COUNT(customer_id) AS customer_count  
FROM customer  
GROUP BY region  
HAVING COUNT(customer_id) > 200 ;
```
